Captial District Kiwanis International Board of Trustees Meeting Portsmouth Virginia August 23, 2019

Governor Morris called the board of Trustees to order at 9 AM.

All members except for Trustee Fred Lohnes were present.

Kiwanis International Trustee, 2019-2020 Capital District counselor was in attendance along with several Past Governors and Lieutenant Governors

The Agenda was approved as distributed and in the Board Book.

The minutes of March 8, 2019 and June1, 2019 were approved as distributed in the Board Book.

The financial reports for the CKI, Key Club and District were included in the Board Book.

Finance Committee Chair reported that there was balance of \$713,088 in the Edward Jones account as of July 26, 2019. The represents a growth from \$701,568 in the past month and from \$709,178 in the past year.

Membership was at 4451, which is plus 75 as of 26 and we ae plus 84 as of today. Clubs have been lost or suspended their charters. The monthly reports are included in the Board Book.

The Board of Trustees unanimously a recommendation to the 2019 House of Delegated to nominate current Kiwanis International President Elect for the office of the 2020 – 2021 President of Kiwanis International.

The motion was approved unanimously.

Past Governor Tyner reported that 155 of the MNT matches have been used by District Kiwanis to date. We are still \$470,000 short of the amount assigned to the District by Kiwanis International. Every club in the District has donated including our new clubs.

Administrator Serena Bell announced a very successful year and ICON. Past Governor Jose was elected to the office of International Trustee and was named a Distinguished Governor, and the District was Distinguished.

Committee Reports are in the Board Book.

Governor John thanked everyone for their hard work and dedication. He pointed out the District still has challenges in membership, finances, and service. The District Board needs to work with the District Committee Chairs to recruit members from each region.

The 2019 - 2020 Board of Trustees meeting will be held at K-Family Weekend in Front Royal, Virginia at the K-Family Weekend, September 13 - 15, 2019 at the Northern Virginia 4-H Camp.

Capital District Kiwanis International Board of Trustees Meeting Telecon September 22, 2019

Governor-Designate Lurie called the board of Trustees to order at 8:35 p.m. All members except Secretary Tom Varner and Trustee Renee Mackey were on the call.

Governor-Designate Lurie explained the purpose of the call was to complete the agenda items from the board meeting in Front Royal on September 14. He had emailed the agenda two days prior.

1. The first item addressed the request for supporting hurricane relief in the Bahamas. Trustee Elana Gardner pointed out that in previous years our district had sent \$10,000 to the Texas-Oklahoma and Florida districts and perhaps we should consider something similar in the Bahamas in 2019. The question was raised as to the Kiwanis presence in the Bahamas; Trustee Dennis Baugh said that according the KI web site, there are nine clubs there composed of approximately 500 members.

Trustee Bill Watson moved that we earmark \$5,000 for Bahamas hurricane relief, Trustee Ron McCallum seconded and discussion was open.

Outgoing Governor John Morris made the point there will be disaster situations routinely in the future and our obligation to repeat such contributions could be extensive. After further discussion, John suggested we table the discussion until we have a better idea of the actual needs. Bill withdrew his motion, Ron withdrew his second.

2. The next item addressed club and division distinguished criteria, which KI has delegated to districts to develop. Dennis moved that in order to achieve distinguished club status, we require clubs to contribute \$10 per member to the Kiwanis Chlldren's Fund and \$5 to the Capital District Foundation; have all SLP advisors in compliance with Youth Protection Guideline training and also submit to a current criminal background check. This motion also requires that for a division to earn distinguished status, 80 percent of clubs need to submit all monthly reports, election reports and also to have 100 percent of their clubs in compliance with YPG and criminal background checks. Trustee Jack Hassman seconded.

After discussion, Dennis and Jack withdrew their motion and second until sufficient research could be done as to the reasonable level of achievement of these standards. Dennis will put

something in writing and distribute it to the board. Another telecon will be held prior to the November 16 board meeting.

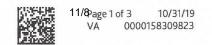
- 3. David opened the Awards Program discussion, pointing out the Capital District at one time had a fairly robust program but we have since moved away from it. Do we want to bring it back? Elana spoke in favor of doing so; John Morris thought the proposed list of awards was too extensive and the presentation of them would dominate district meetings. David suggested we at least make a start. With responsibility of oversight of the proposed program, John agreed to look over a program in the Florida District; he asked David to send him their categories and criteria.
- 4. Key Leader budget. John Morris moved we approve the proposed budget that was in the board book; Elana seconded and the motion passed.
- 5. Finance report. David explained we still did not have the August figures so we will wait on this item until our November board meeting.
- 6. Ron had questions regarding the Teenager of the Year program. He would like to see the process documented in a policy. Currently there is a lack of clarity. It was agreed we will take a look at the application and process at the November board meeting.

There being no further business, David Lurie adjourned the meeting at 10 p.m.

At the Kiwanis North America International Secretary and Executive Director meeting in Indianapolis, we were furnished with printout titles District and Provisional District Status Report dated November 4, 2019. It contained status (Acceptable and Deficiency) for all the Districts in Kiwanis.

The areas are:

Bylaws Compliance

Convention Reporting

Annual Financial Audit (including Reviews)

Government Reporting Compliance (990)

Growth Efforts (over last 3 years)

Capital District was Acceptable in all areas except Annual Financial Audit where we had a Deficiency. This was dude to the Capital District Foundation not submitting either the 990 or Audit Report. The 990 was submitted and received by Kiwanis International and that time was removed. However, the District is deficient because the Audit Report had been submitted.

I had a lengthy discussion with the Kiwanis International Financial Officers – Bob Broderick and Bill Parker - and received clarification on some items I was concerned about.

First, I was always under the impression District could not interfere or appear to have control over the Foundation since it is a C3. According to the Kiwanis International we cannot dictate investment type decision.

All other administrative matters are subject to District oversight. Specifically, Bob and Bill and the COO stated that as District Secretary, copies of all reports should be submitted to me in an expedient manner to include meeting minutes, budgets, 990, and annual financial review.

Based on these discussions and directions, I have informed the Foundation Leadership that in the future the following will be required immediately.

Minutes of Meetings no later than 21 days after the meeting. (Same time frame as exists at the District)

Quarterly (or meeting) financial report no later than 21 days after the meeting.

Annual Tax Return within 30 days of the end of the Kiwanis Year. (October 31)

Audit/Review of financial records. (October 31)

<u>2019-2020 Regional Growth Summary</u>: +2 members net, 1,006 total members, no new club opened...yet! 3 of 29 clubs positive net growth, 1 of 29 clubs negative net growth. Five of 29 clubs with less than Charter-strength,

<u>Division 12</u> (LTG James Shackelford)

- 1. Name of the Division Club Counselor and Growth Chair: Club Counsellors Mary Beth Murphy, Dave Rothberg, Caren Schumacher, James Shackelford and Missy Zimmerman. Growth Chairs Murphy, Rothberg, Schumacher, Shackelford, Missy Zimmerman and Scott Zimmerman.
- 2. Lieutenant Governor submitted copy of club reports to Trustee: Visits completed. Contact Visit Report due NLT 30 Nov 19
- 3. Membership growth/decrease: +1 Total 500... 2 of 9 clubs have net growth ... 1 of 9 clubs is net negative. All clubs are above Charter-strength.
- 4. Plans for new club (s): King William and West Point are two potential areas. Initial review/analysis worked has been completed. During the next few weeks will have a decision where to concentrate our efforts. Recently, the Warsaw area, or area north of Tappahannock, has popped up on my radar. An analysis for a potential club will probably not be done until a club has been formed in one of the first two areas.
- 5. Plans for new SLP's: (1) Work has commenced for a Key Club in Charles City, club sponsor New Kent. A Faculty Advisor has been identified. A group of 15 students have been identified. Meetings and conversations are on going. Hope to have club paper work submitted to KI within the next 30 days.
 - (2) Discussions have taken place with Principal of New Kent High School. New Kent club to be sponsor. There is a great deal of interest, both at the school and the Kiwanis New Kent Club. A Faculty Advisor has not been identified. As soon as that happens, I expect to see process accelerate. Hope to have club in place by end of year.
 - (3) There is some interest in restarting the Lancaster High School Key Club (charter suspended). The club was sponsored by the Northern Neck Club and they are having on going discussions with school administrators. There is no firm conviction yet that the club will be re-established.
- New Kent had its first club fund raiser 10/26. They sold approximately 180 quarts of Brunswick stew. Estimate about \$1,100 profit. Funds for two Key Clubs.
- As of 8 Aug 19, ALL Division 12 club had conducted elections, and submitted election reports for 2019-2020!

- 3. Membership growth/decrease: +1 Total 208 1 of 9 clubs has net growth. Seven of 9 clubs are above Charter-strength, but 6 of the 9 clubs have 20 members or less.
- 4. Plans for new club (s): None. Only 2 of 9 clubs in the division are "healthy" size, although most are very active and serving their communities. Emphasis will be put on strengthening/increasing membership in these clubs, rather than opening a new club. This is a geographically compact division, thus opening a new club will likely pull members from existing clubs.
- 5. Plans for new SLP's: New SLPs are a priority with the start of a new school year. Have some encouragement on a new Key Club at Kecoughtan High School, where there is a willing Faculty Advisor.
- The Peninsula at Oyster Point club, which was considering closing or merging, now has an active and growing Satellite Committee. This club is successful but lack of growth is frustrating older members. This is a prototypical "old" club and needs some fresh, younger members, but the SatelliteCommittee is helping and will be the future of the club.
 - Newport News City Center club has worked things out with KI and its Charter has been reinstated. It is coming along with several new members set to join in November. This is a 3-2-1 club that only meets twice each month, which doesn't provide much continuity. A year ago tis club was set to fold and it is now growing...currently at 11 members.
 - As of 26 October 19, City Center, Peninsula at Oyster Point, and Smithfield have not yet conducted elections, and/or submitted election reports for 2019-2020. ;-(
 - The rest of the clubs are hanging in there.
