- Clubs send out to ALL schools as soon as they receive it. Guidance directors are excellent POC. <u>Send out to private</u>, parochial and non-SLP schools also.
- Students are made aware of award and online application process.
- Students complete applications by <u>February 1, 2021</u> at 5 p.m. which then go to clubs.
- **February** Club ToY committee reviews and chooses winner that goes to LG.
- <u>March</u> Division committee reviews and chooses winner that goes to District Chair.
- <u>April</u> District committee review and chooses district winner who wins the \$2500 cash award. Winner announced <u>May 1st</u>.




